

Anti-Displacement Program



The CLTRE Keeper is an 8-week home buying program specifically designed for people within culturally rich neighborhoods. The goal of the program is to provide community members with the knowledge, resources, and support they need to navigate the home buying process and become successful homeowners.

Additionally, the program highlights economic opportunities such as government-backed home buying programs and down payment assistance programs, as well as suggested partnerships with local real estate agents, financial advisors, and nonprofit organizations that can provide further support.

The **CLTRE** Accelerator is a rigorous program designed to boost entrepreneurs' mastery of business and entrepreneurship concepts, self-confidence as an entrepreneurial leader, and access to networks of entrepreneurial resources. The 6-week Innovation Challenge includes twice weekly course meetings, mentorship, and 1 on 1 guidance sessions with faculty.

Metrics of Success:

84% BIPOC entrepreneurs participated in the program

85% of entrepreneurs increased their confidence in their ability to build a profitable business model

100% of entrepreneurs are now confident or very confident they can grow their business



DISPLAY is our retail space designed to support thousands of local makers and designers by giving them a platform to sell their products, receive real-time feedback on offerings, and gain access to a supportive hyper-local community. We also use it as a tool to train young adults ages 16-24 on customer service, sales techniques, visuals, inventory, and cash handling.

Metrics of Success:

How many locally made products we have in the store: 80
How much the store makes annually in dollars: \$117,803.28
How many annual transactions made in the store: 3,810
How many people come into the store monthly visitors: 150

The **CLTRE** Club is a retail training cohort designed to provide 8-10 entrepreneurs with access to an affordable retail space that serves as a platform for showcasing their brand, an incubation space for up-and-coming entrepreneurs to grow their business, and a training facility where they can learn the skills and knowledge necessary to successfully operate a brick-and-mortar business.

Metrics of Success:

- # of entrepreneurs enrolled in the retail cohort: 9
- # of successful brick-and-mortar businesses launched by program graduates:

- # of program participants who continue operating their businesses beyond the program duration: 7
